FACT SHEET 4 - Theory Test

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- The Theory Test is completed at a test centre and is carried out as a computer exercise.
- There is time allowed for a 15 minute practice session, which offers the opportunity to become familiar with the system and guidance on how to complete the Multiple Choice Element of the test.
- 40 minutes are allowed to complete the Multiple Choice section of the test, which comprises of 35 questions - of which, you must complete 35 correct answers to pass the test.
- Optional trial questions may be added which may eventually be included in future tests. You do not have to complete these questions and they will not be included as part of your score.
- At the end of the Multiple Choice section you may take a three minute break, during this break you must remain at your desk.
- The Hazard Perception Element of the test starts with a video tutorial, this may be watched twice if necessary.
- The clips you will be marked on will be shown once, so concentration is essential.
- The pass mark for the Hazard Perception Element of the test is 44 marks out of a possible 75.
- The computer automatically records your responses.
- YOU NEED TO PASS BOTH PARTS OF THE TEST AT THE SAME SITTING. FAILURE IN EITHER ELEMENT WILL REQUIRE COMPLETION OF ALL ELEMENTS AT RETEST.
- You will receive your results at the Administrators' desk and if successful, receive your Official Driving Theory Test Certificate with your results letter.
- Facilities for special needs candidates are available and should be requested at the time of booking the test.
- Free loan of training CDs, information and advice are available to students preparing for the theory test, who have booked training sessions.
